Katie and Maria have \$35.00 each to spend at Bairds' Choice Book Store, where all students receive a 20% discount. They both want to purchase a copy of the same book, which normally sells for \$37.50 plus 10% sales tax.

- To check if she has enough to purchase the book, Katie takes 20% of \$37.50 and subtracts that amount from the normal price. She takes 10% of the discounted selling price and adds it back to find the purchase amount.
- Maria takes 80% of the normal purchase price and then computes 110% of the reduced price.
