## 28 Sales Tax

## Example 1

Amy reserves a hotel room for $\$ 45$ per night. She stays for two nights and pays a sales tax of $13 \%$. How much tax did she pay?
$\$ 45 \cdot 2=\$ 90$
Find the total price for the hotel stay.
$\$ 90 \cdot 0.13=\$ 11.70 \quad$ Write the tax rate as a decimal and multiply by the total price.

Amy spent $\$ 11.70$ on sales tax.

## Example 2

If the sales tax rate is 6.75\%, how much tax would Juan pay if he bought two CDs at \$16.99 each and one DVD for $\$ 36.29$ ?

CD: 2 at $\$ 16.99 \longrightarrow \$ 33.98$
DVD: 1 at $\$ 36.29$
Total Price
$0.0675 \cdot 70.27=4.743225$ Write the tax rate as
a decimal and multiply by the total price.

Juan would pay $\$ 4.75$ in sales tax.

## Sales Tax

Sales tax is the tax on the sale of an item or service. It is a percent of the purchase price and is collected by the seller.
