28 Sales Tax

Example 1

Amy reserves a hotel room for \$45 per night. She stays for two nights and pays a sales tax of 13%. How much tax did she pay?

Find the total price for the hotel stay.

Write the tax rate as a decimal and multiply by the total price.

Amy spent \$11.70 on sales tax.

Example 2

If the sales tax rate is 6.75%, how much tax would Juan pay if he bought two CDs at \$16.99 each and one DVD for \$36.29?

CD: 2 at \$16.99 → \$33.98

DVD: 1 at \$36.29 → \$36.29

\$70.27

Total Price

0.0675 • 70.27 = 4.743225 Write the tax rate as a decimal and multiply by the total price.

Juan would pay \$4.75 in sales tax.
